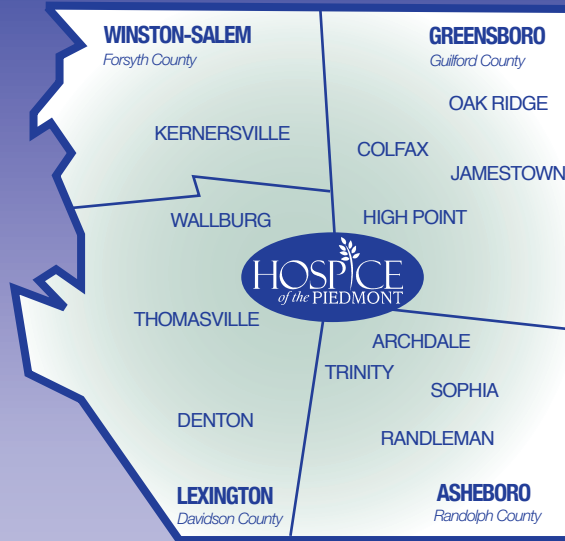

An Overview of Services





Hospice Care

The Hospice team provides expert medical care and support services for patients of all ages with any life-limiting illness. Care is provided in their own homes, but also in assisted living and long-term care facilities. Support is also offered to caregivers as they cope with changing roles.



Kids Path

Kids Path is a program designed to meet the special needs of seriously ill or grieving children and teens. Services range from in-home nursing care to counseling and specialized programs for children and their families.



Palliative Care Services

Palliative care consultations are offered to those at any stage of a serious illness who may benefit from expert symptom management and coordination of care.



Hospice Home at High Point

Opened in 2006, our 14-bed inpatient facility — Hospice Home at High Point — provides round-the-clock care in its home-like setting to patients with a diagnosis of weeks rather than months.



Care Connection Home Health

Care Connection is Hospice of the Piedmont's home health division which provides skilled care to homebound patients with a life-threatening illness, whether they are pursuing curative treatment or not.



Grief Counseling Center

Counselors with the Grief Counseling Center offer grief support in individual and group settings; both to family members of Hospice patients, as well as anyone in the community grieving the loss of a loved one.

Team Approach

Our interdisciplinary care teams include a range of professionals:

- Full-time physician/medical director
- Registered nurses on call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- Medical social workers
- Nursing assistants
- Chaplains
- Kids Path counselor
- Bereavement counselors
- Other therapists as needed
- Specially-trained patient/family volunteers

Funding
